# HAMLET OF ENTERPRISE

## BYLAW NUMBER 46

---

A Bylaw of the Municipal Corporation of the Hamlet of Enterprise in the Northwest Territories to provide for a municipal emergency program, pursuant to the provisions of the Civil Emergency Measures Act, R.S.N.W.T., 1988, c. C-9, s. 7.

---

WHEREAS, the Hamlet of Enterprise deems it necessary to provide for emergency services within the municipality;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE HAMLET OF ENTERPRISE, at a duly assembled meeting, enacts as follows:

### 1. CITATION

1. This by-law may be cited as the "**CIVIL EMERGENCIES BYLAW.**"

### 2. INTERPRETATION

1. In this Bylaw:
  - a) "Council" means the Council of the Hamlet of Enterprise;
  - b) "Hamlet" means the Hamlet of Enterprise in the Northwest Territories;
  - c) "Mayor" means the Mayor of the Hamlet; and,
  - d) "Senior Administrative Officer" means the Senior Administrative Officer of the Hamlet

### 3. GENERAL

1. That the Hamlet of Enterprise Emergency Response Committee is established.
2. That the members of the Hamlet of Enterprise Emergency Response Committee be appointed by motion of council.
3. That the Senior Administrative Officer [SAO] is appointed Emergency Response coordinator and duties shall include:
  - a) Acting as secretary and coordinator of the Hamlet of Enterprise Emergency Response Committee.
  - b) Preparing, maintaining, and coordinating the Hamlet of Enterprise Emergency Response Plan.

- c) Preparing and coordinating emergency programs as directed by Council.
- 4. That the council shall submit the Hamlet of Enterprise Emergency Response Plan to the Minister of Municipal and Community Affairs.

4. EFFECTIVE DATE

- 1. This bylaw is effective upon third and final reading.
